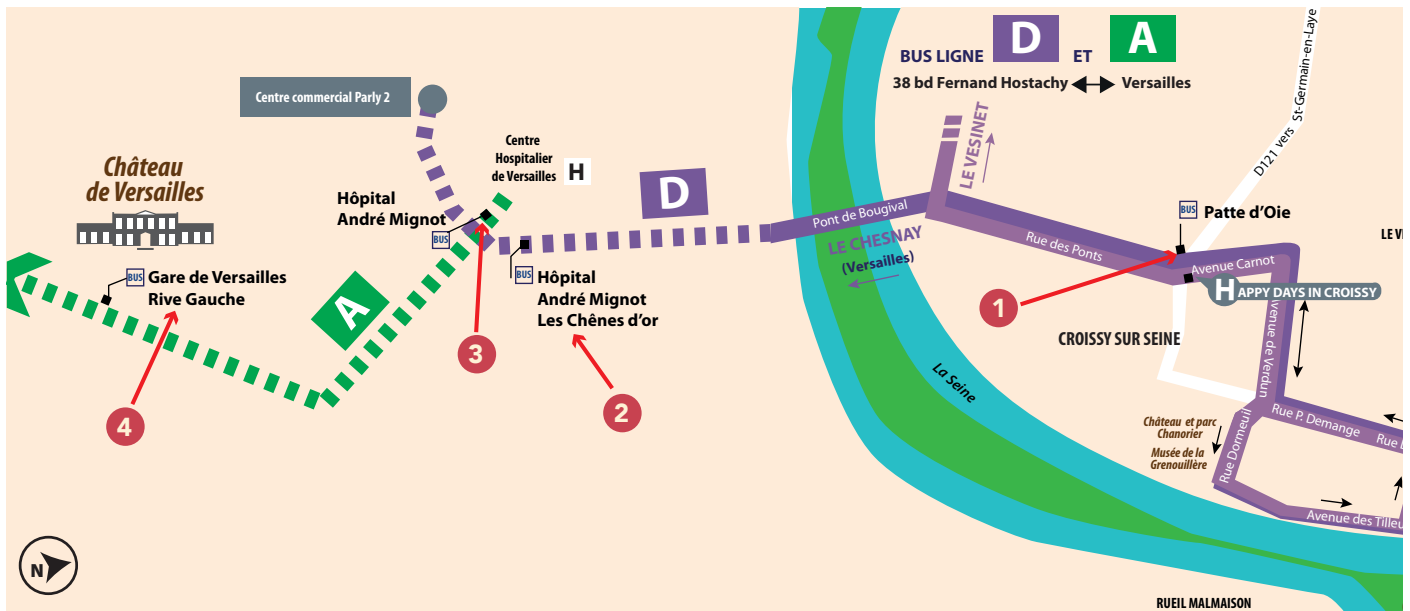

# From Croissy to Versailles

A • Bus D + Bus A



- 1 To go to Versailles, you take bus D, from the PATTE D'OIE stop, located in front of the building, on the other side of the street.



- 2 Get off at Hôpital André Mignot



- 3 Walk to the stop of Bus A, Hôpital André Mignot, towards Versailles Satory (2 minutes walk).



- 4 Get off bus A at Gare Versailles Rive Gauche stop. Just on the opposite side of the station.

- 5** → From the Versailles Château Rive Gauche stop, you're almost there. You will take 5 minutes to walk 400 meters between the station and the entrance to the castle.

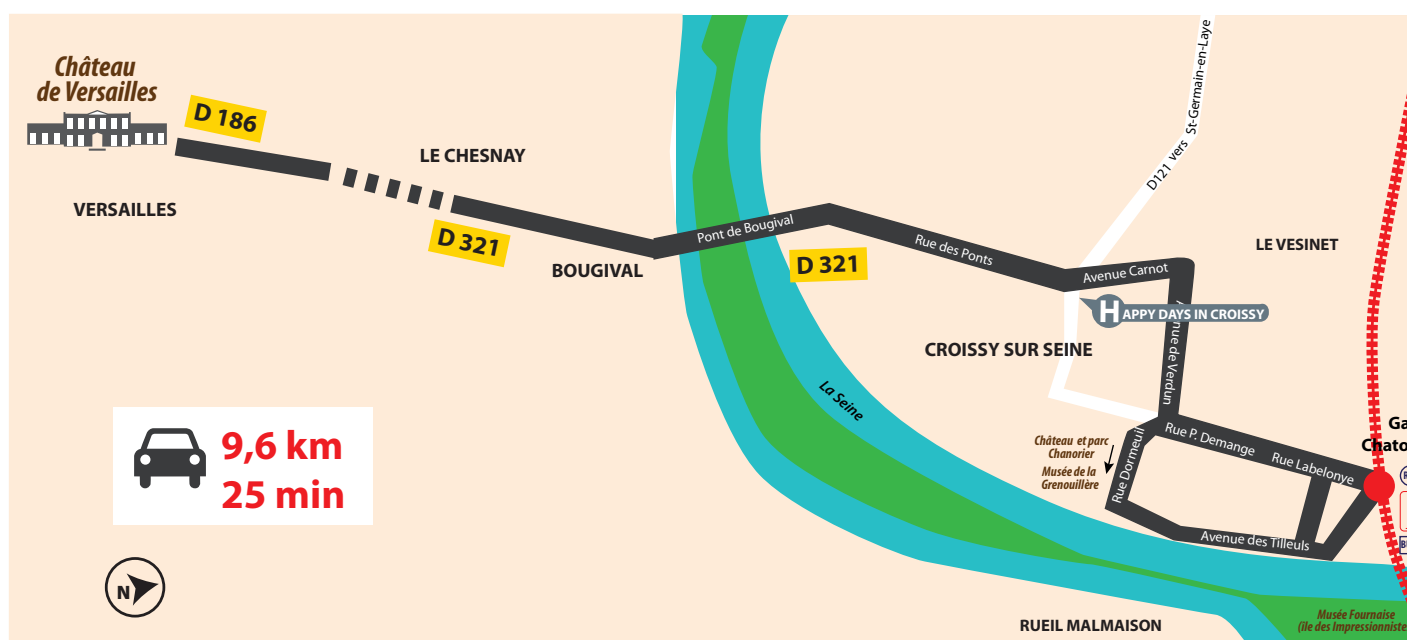

## B • Instructions to go to Versailles by car

Going to Versailles by car is the most convenient way. In addition it is also the fastest way since it will take you 25 minutes (without traffic jam), to cover the 9.6 kilometers between the apartment and the Palace of Versailles.

- Either you have your personal vehicle
- Or we can put at your disposal, our automatic Mégane (for the low price of 25 € / day)
- Or you take an Uber or a taxi



- Take the Rue des Ponts (D 321) (signs to Bougival / La Celle St Cloud / Versailles)
- Continue to follow D321 - 10 min (5.1km)
- Follow Rue de Versailles towards Boulevard du Roi / D186 in Versailles 6min (2.3km)
- Continue on D186. Take Rue des Réservoirs towards Rockefeller Avenue 5min (1.7km)
- Continue on Rockefeller Avenue towards your destination
